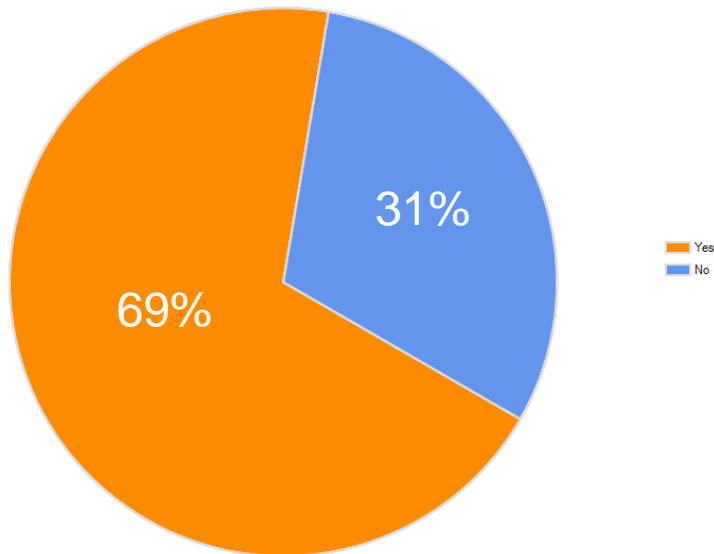

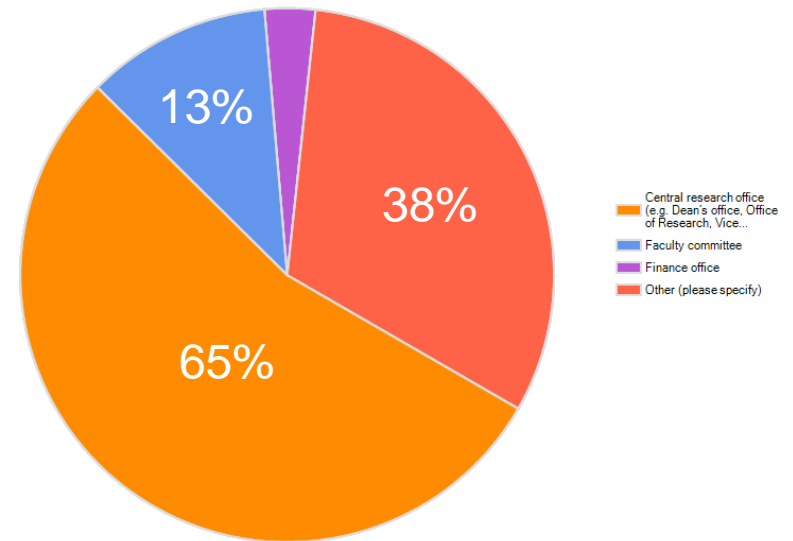
Does your institution have centralized oversight of core facilities? (N = 88)

Does your institution have centralized oversight of core facilities?



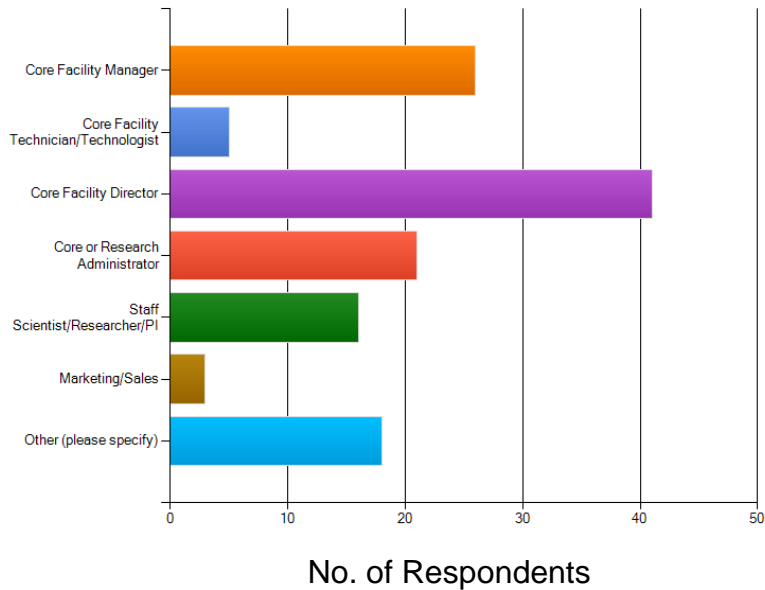

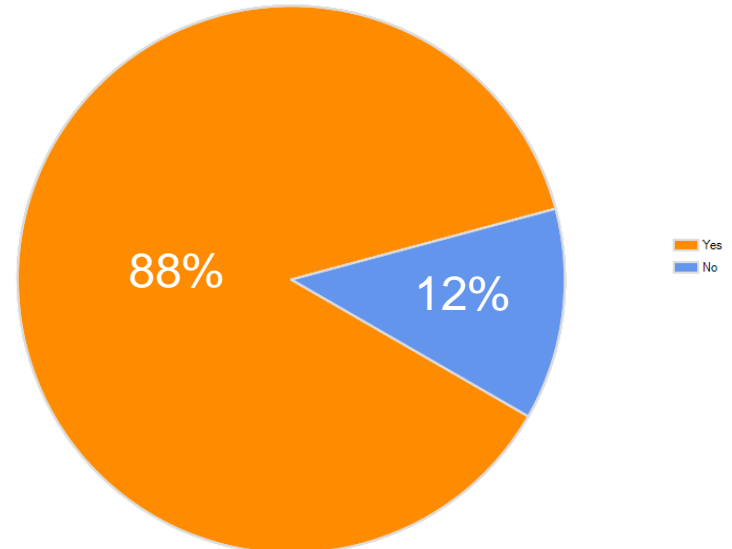
What is your institutional role?

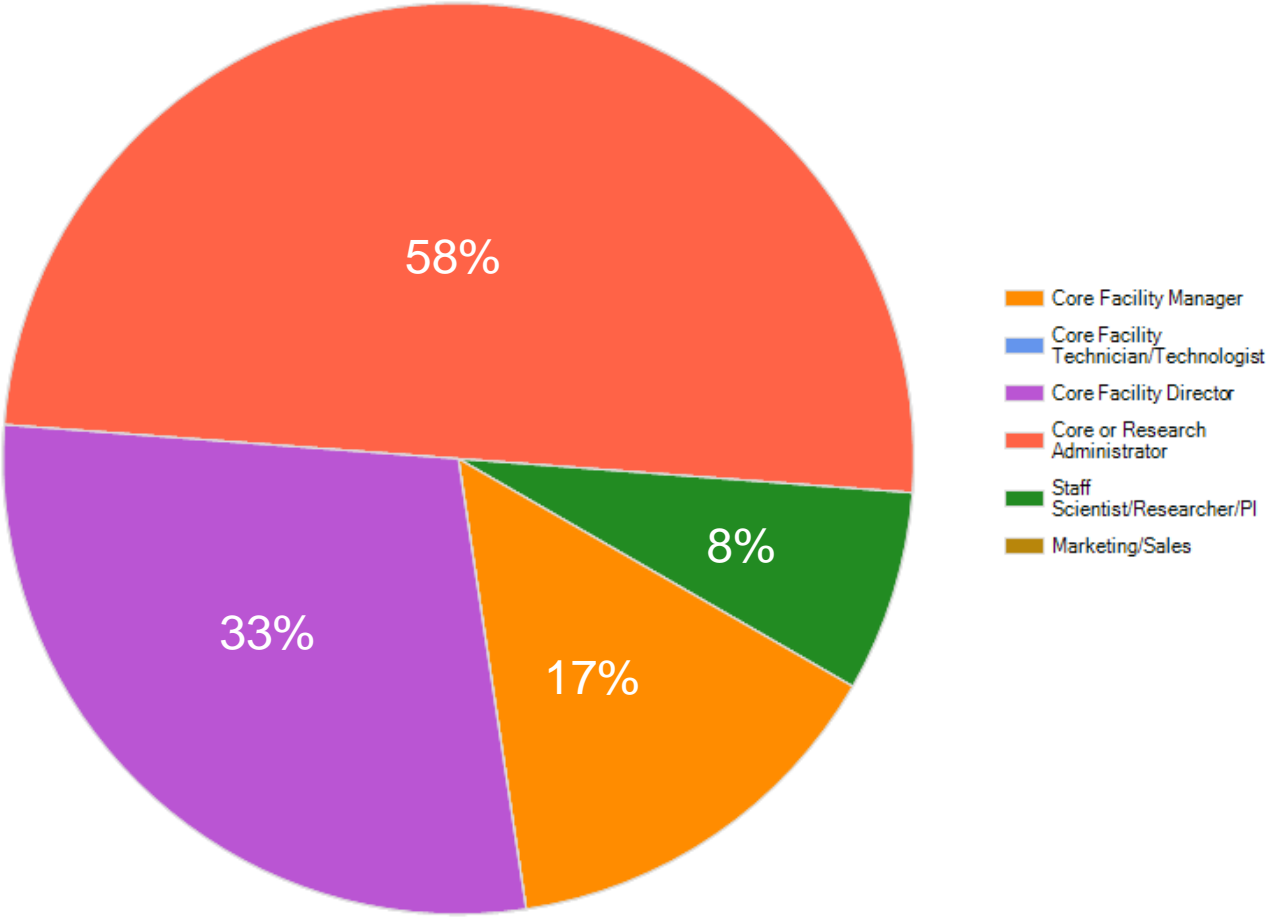

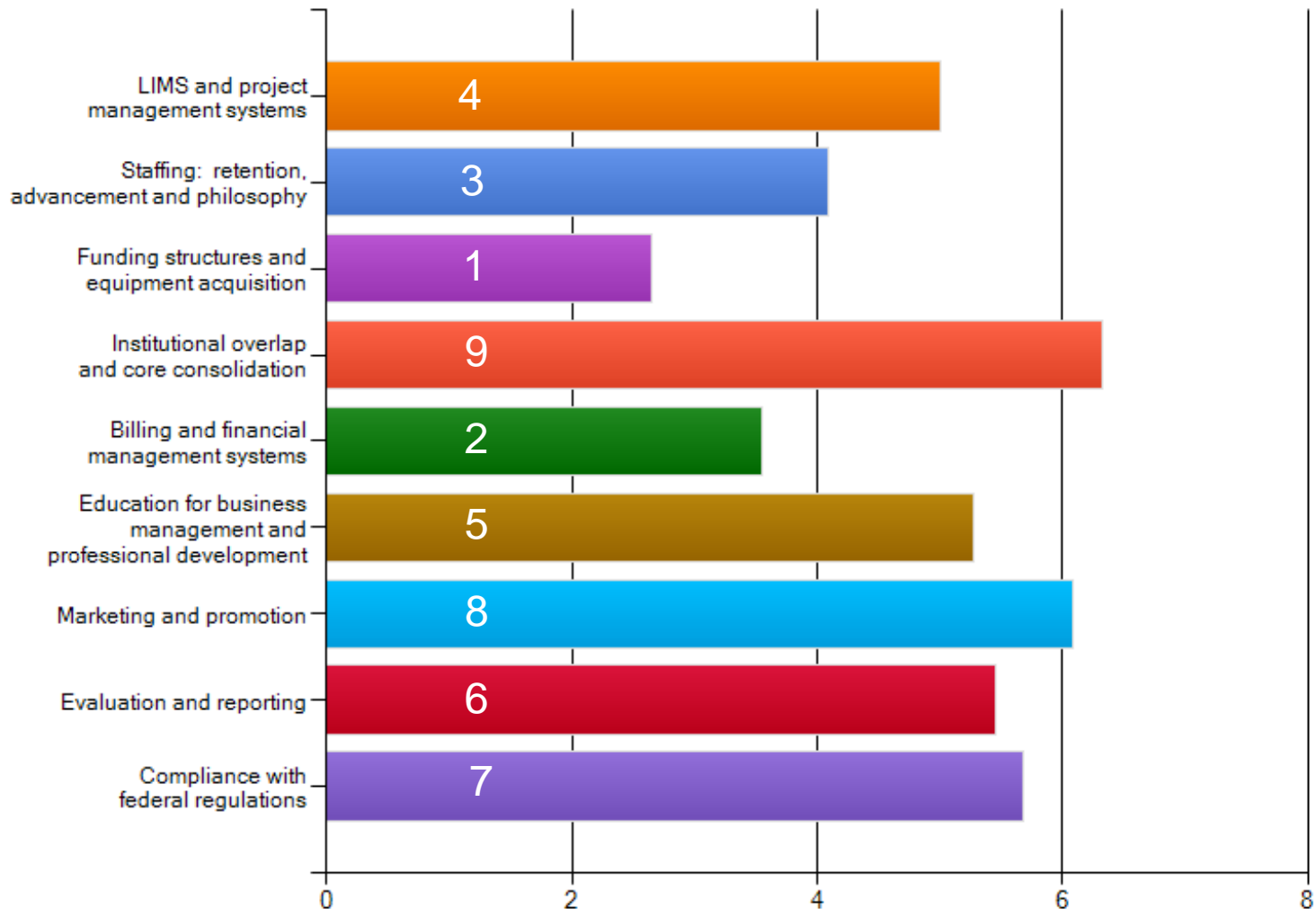
What is your institutional role? Please select all that apply: N=24

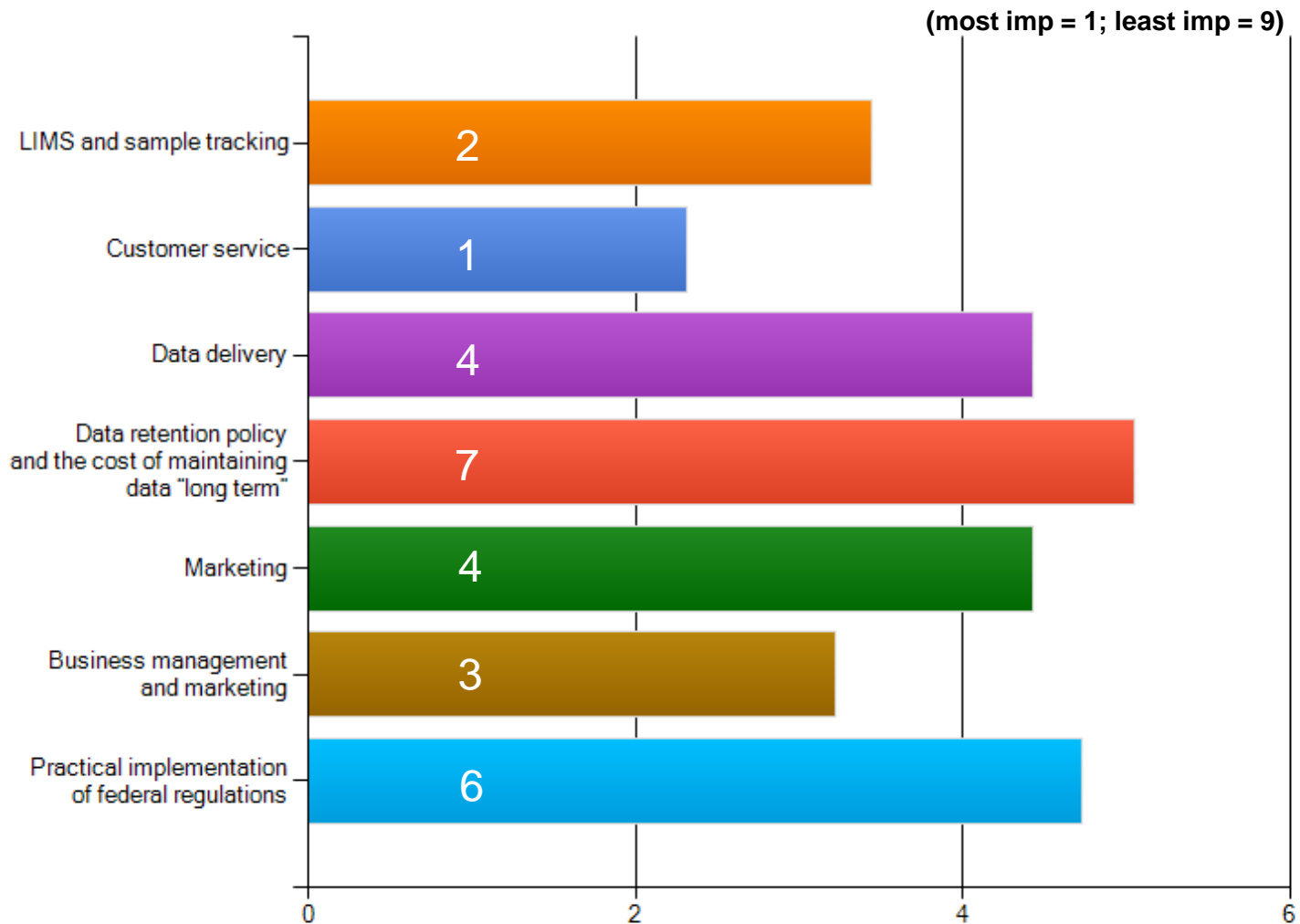
What are the most important issues or concerns for you related to institutional oversight of core facilities? Please rank the following issues:

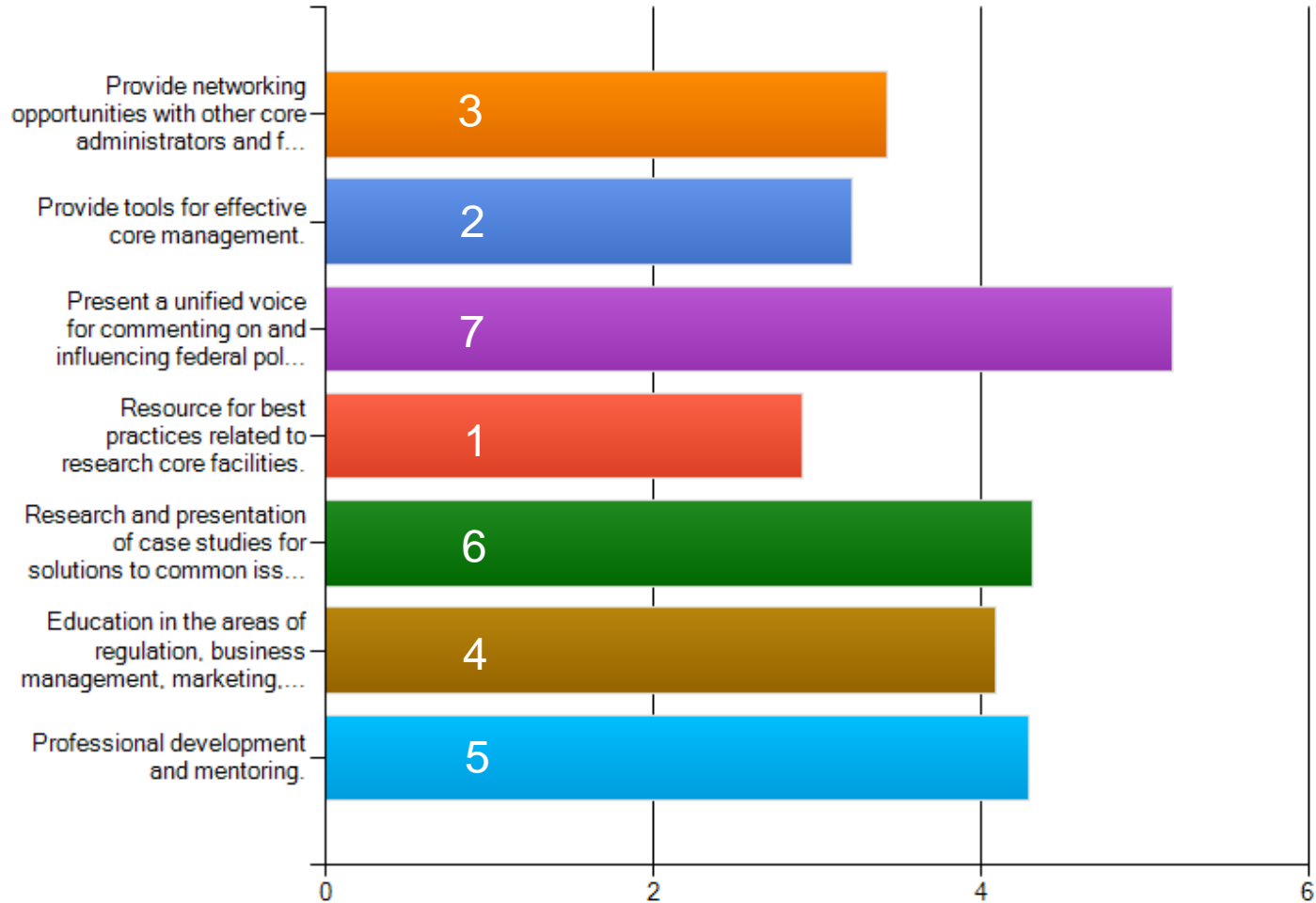
What are the most important issues or concerns for you related to core facility management?

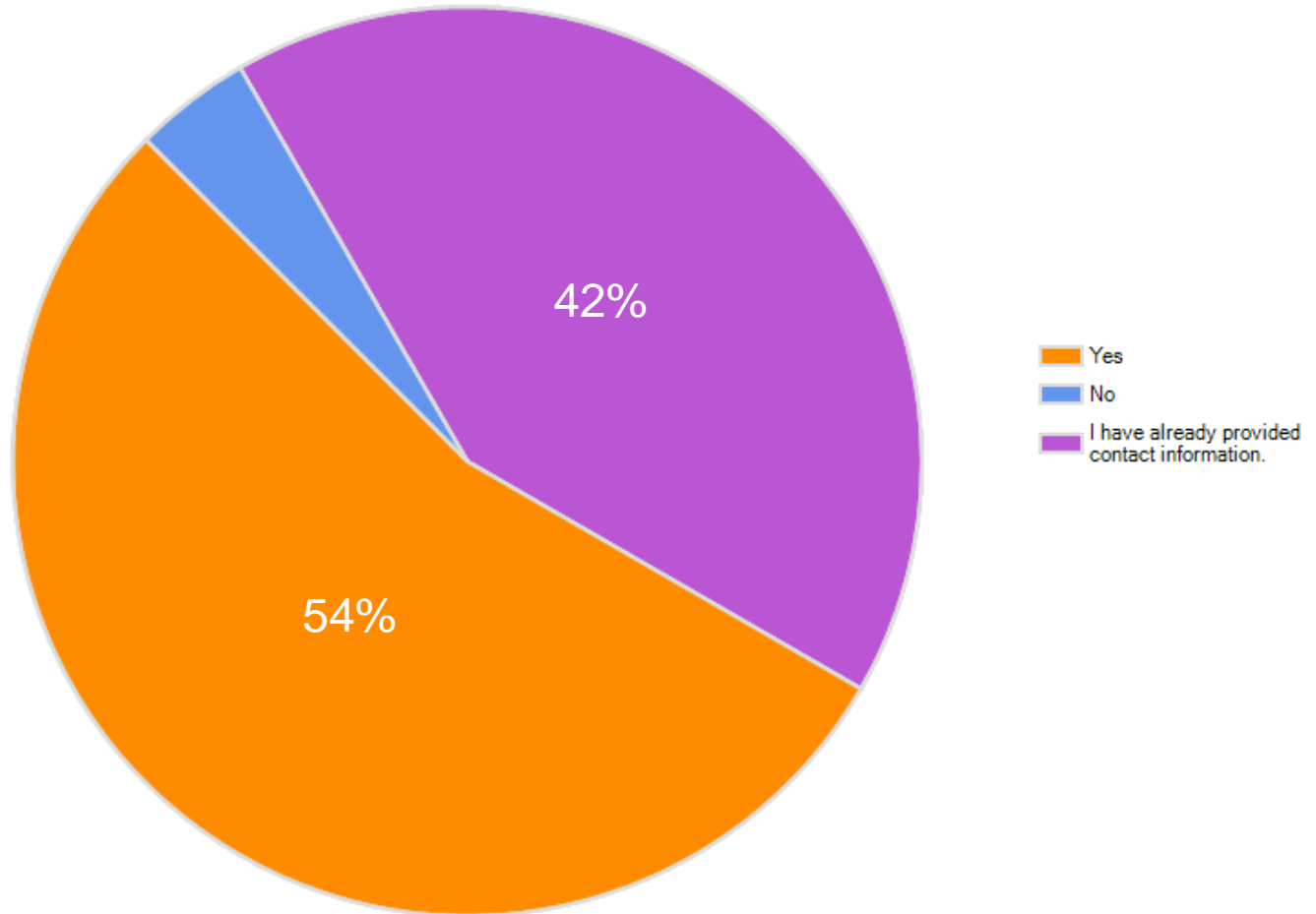
