





If your institution has centralized oversight, who is responsible?







What is your institutional role?

Are you interested in participating In the ABRF Core Admin Network?






No. of Respondents




# Specific Concerns Survey #2 Jan-Feb, 2011

What is your institutional role? Please select all that apply: N=24




What are the most important issues or concerns for you related to institutional oversight of core facilities? Please rank the following issues:

(most imp = 1; least imp = 9)





What are the most important issues or concerns for you related to core facility management?


